Holiday Switch OFF Checklist Stop wasting energy while on holiday





How to use this Checklist

This short checklist has been created to help you stop the energy waste while you're away on holidays so you don't come back unnecessary bills. Here are some of the simple things you can do each time you go away for more than a long weekend.

The list is zoned into the various rooms of a home to make it as easy as possible to identify what can be Switched Off. Before you leave, take this list, walk through your home and simply 'turn it off' and tick the box. On your return, just reverse the process, simple!

Turn items OFF at the power point where possible, or alternatively at the Power On/Off switch. Refrigerators, freezers, alarm systems, phone systems, fish tanks and security lighting should be left on.
